Couplet

In his benevolence, he dispels my troubles and imperfections. Hail to Lord Hanuman, the reservoir of wisdom and virtue, the preeminent beacon among the monkey clan.

Meaning: Your wisdom is unparalleled, your virtue unquestionable, and you are always eager to fulfill Lord Rama's will.

Prabhu Charitra Sunibe Ko Rasiya.

Ram Lakhan Sita Mann Basiya.

Meaning: Your heart brims with delight as you listen to the tales of Lord Rama, Mother Sita, and Lord Laxmana, residing within it.

Sukshma Roop Dhari Siyanhi Dikhawa.

Bikat Roop Dhari Lanka Jarawa.

Meaning: Taking various forms, you played a pivotal role in Lord Rama's endeavors, from appearing subtly before Mother Sita to incinerating Ravana's kingdom.

Bheem Roop Dhari Asura Sanghare.

Ramchandra Ke Kaaj Sanware.

Meaning: By transforming into a gigantic figure like Bheema, you defeated the demons and successfully carried out Lord Rama's assignments.

Laaye Sanjeevan Lakhana Jiyaaye.

Sri Raghuveer Harashi Urr Laaye.

Meaning: Bringing the magic-herb (sanjivani), You revived Lord Laxmana with the magical herb.

Raghupati Keenhi Bahut Badai.

Tum Mum Priya, Bhartahi Sum Bhai.

Meaning: And earned Lord Rama's heartfelt praise, likening you to a dear brother like Bharat.

Sahas Badan Tumharo Jas Gaave.

Asa Kahi Sripati Kanth Lagaave.

Meaning: Uttering these words, Lord Rama drew You close to Himself, and with open arms, He embraced You. Your fame is celebrated not only by sages like Sanaka, gods like Brahma, and sages like Narada but also by the thousand-mouthed serpent.

Sankaadik Brahmadi Munisa.

Narad Sarad Sahit Aheesa.

Meaning: Sanak, Sanandan, and other revered sages and saints, along with Brahma, Narada, Saraswati, and the Serpent King, all join in singing Your divine glory.

Jam Kuber Digpal Jahan Te.

Kabi Kobid Kahi Sake Kahan Te.

Meaning: Even Yama, Kubera, and the guardians of the quarters, along with poets and scholars, find it impossible to fully express your glory.

Tum Upkaar Sugreevahi Keenha.

Ram Milaaye Raj-Pad Deenha.

Meaning: You facilitated Lord Rama's alliance with Sugriva, restoring his kingdom, and guided Vibhishana to the throne of Lanka.

Tumharo Mantra Bibhishan Maana.

Lankeshwar Bhaye Sab Jag Jaana.

Meaning: In a similar manner, by following Your guidance, Vibhishana ascended to the throne as the King of Lanka.

Leelyo Taahi Madhur Phal Jaanu.

Meaning: You famously mistook the distant sun for a sweet fruit and carried Lord Rama's ring across the ocean without a second thought.

Prabhu Mudrika Meli Mukh Maahi.

Jaladhi Laandhi Gaye Achraj Naahi.

Meaning: With Lord Rama's ring held securely in Your mouth, You effortlessly traversed the ocean, a feat that left everyone unsurprised.

Durgam Kaaj Jagat Ke Jete.

Sugam Anugrah Tumhare Tete.

Meaning: Your grace makes even the most challenging tasks in this world seem remarkably simple.

Ram Duaare Tum Rakhvare.

Hott Na Aagya Binu Paisare.

Meaning: You stand as the guardian at the entrance to Lord Rama's abode. Without Your permission, no one can progress, signifying that the blessed sight of Lord Rama is only attainable through Your benevolence.

Sab Sukh Lahe Tumhari Sarna.

Tum Rakshak Kahu Ko Dar Na.

Meaning: Those who seek Your refuge discover boundless comfort and joy. With a protector like You, there is no need to fear anyone or anything.

Aapan Tej Samharo Aape.

Teeno Lok Haank Te Kaampe.

Meaning: Your magnificence is so awe-inspiring that only You can endure it. A single roar from You sets all three worlds aquiver.

Bhoot Pishaach Nikat Nahi Aavein.

Mahaveer Jab Naam Sunaave."

Meaning: O Mahaveer! Remembering Your name keeps ghosts and malevolent spirits at bay, highlighting the tremendous power in simply invoking Your name.

Naase Rog Hare Sab Peera.

Japat Nirantar Hanumat Beera.

Meaning: O Hanuman! Every ailment and form of suffering vanishes when Your name is recited or chanted. Hence, regular recitation of Your name holds immense significance.

Sankat Te Hanuman Churave.

Mann Kram Vachan Dhyaan Jo Laave.

Meaning: Those who meditate on You, offer worship through thought, word, and action, find liberation from all forms of turmoil and distress.

Sab Par Ram Tapasvi Raja.

Tin Ke Kaaj Sakal Tum Saaja.

Meaning: While Lord Rama stands as the supreme ascetic among kings, it is You who accomplished all of Lord Sri Rama's endeavors.

Aur Manorath Jo Koi Laave.

Soi Amit Jivan Phal Paave.

Meaning: Those who approach You with any aspiration or heartfelt desire receive an unending abundance of the desired fruit, which remains eternal throughout their lives.

Chaaron Yug Partap Tumhara.

Hai Parsidh Jagat Ujiyara.

Meaning: Your splendor radiates across all four ages, and Your renown extends throughout the world.

Saadhu-Sant Ke Tum Rakhvare.

Asur Nikandan Ram Dulaare."

Meaning: You are the protector of saints and sages, the vanquisher of demons, and deeply cherished by Lord Rama.

Ashta Siddhi Nau Nidhi Ke Daata.

As Var Deen Janaki Mata.

Meaning: Mother Janaki's blessings empower You to bestow boons upon the deserving, granting them siddhis (eight mystical powers) and nidhis (nine forms of wealth).

Ram Rasayan Tumhare Paasa.

Sadaa Raho Raghupati Ke Daasa.

Meaning: Your essence is pure devotion to Lord Rama, and may You forever remain the humble and devoted servant of Raghupati.

Tumhare Bhajan Ram Ko Paave.

Janam Janam Ke Dukh Bisraave.

Meaning: When one sings Your praises and reveres Your name, they not only have the opportunity to meet Lord Rama but also find solace from the sorrows accumulated over many lifetimes.

Antkaal Raghuvar Pur Jaayi.

Jahan Janam Hari-Bhakt Kahayi.

Meaning: Through Your benevolence, one attains the everlasting abode of Lord Rama after death and maintains unwavering devotion to Him.

Aur Devta Chitta Na Dharai.

Hanumat Sei Sarva Sukh Karai.

Meaning: There is no necessity to serve any other deity or god; serving Lord Hanuman brings all comforts.

Sankat Kate, Mite Sab Peera.

Jo Sumire Hanumat Balbeera.

Meaning: For those who recall the mighty Lord Hanuman, all troubles vanish, and their pains find their resolution.

Jai Jai Jai Hanuman Gosain.

Krupa Karahu Gurudev Ki Naai.

Meaning: Hail Lord Hanuman, our Supreme Guru, who bestows grace and blessings upon us.

Jo Sat Baar Paath Kar Koi.

Chutahi Bandhi Maha Sukh Hoyi.

Meaning: Reciting this Chalisa a hundred times releases one from all bondage and brings great bliss.

Jo Yeh Padhe Hanuman Chalisa,

Hoye Siddhi Saakhi Gaurisa.

Meaning: Those who read and recite this Hanuman Chalisa find success in all their endeavors, with Lord Shiva Himself as the witness to this truth.

Meaning: Tulsidas humbly prays, "O Lord Hanuman, may I forever remain a devoted servant of Lord Sri Ram," and may You eternally reside in my heart.
